The Department of Telecommunications (DoT) through its letter no. 20-281/2010-AS-I dated 21.12.2012 referred the Terms and Conditions for Unified License (Access Services)" to TRAI.

In the letter of DoT it is stated that there is a requirement to issue fresh licenses to the successful new entrants in the auction of spectrum held in November 2012 and it is decided that as an interim measures a Service Area Level Unified License (Access Service) may be granted only to the new entrants referred above.
