1. TRAI launches Mobile App "TRAI My Speed" – Consumers can now check their Wireless Data Speeds

TRAI launched a mobile app "TRAI Myspeed" App on 5th July, 2016. Using this App, consumerscan check their wireless data speeds, upload and down load.

The App also measures network delay and packet loss. The App has provision for consumers to share their data experience with TRAI.

This consumer friendly App can be downloaded free of cost from "Mobile Sewa" App Store and "Google Play Store".



2. TRAI Hackathon for complaint handling Mechanism on 9th-10th July, 2016:

TRAI hosted a "36- hour Hackathon" on 9-10th July, 2016 at Bangalore seeking technology based solutions for the broadening issue of telecom complaint handling in India. TRAI sought ideas, challenges and alternatives would that enable the telecom industry to resolve consumer related issues using technology.

The event avid saw participation of 17 teams of software developers and data analysts. The event brought highly skilled software developers together to develop solutions to manage the complaints of telecom subscribers the across country and to improve overall customer experience. The solutions developed the teams were evaluated by an expert judging panel and top four teams were awarded cash prizes of Rs. 1 lac, Rs. 50, 000, Rs. 30,000 and Rs 20,000 respectively.







The concepts and technological solutions emerged from the Hackathon are under process with the objective of designing an efficient consumer complaint redressal system.

Recommendations:

1. Recommendations on "Valuation and Reserve Price of Spectrum in the 700 MHz, 800 MHz, 900 MHz, 1800MHz, 2100MHz, 2300MHz and 2500 MHz bands"

The Authority had sent its recommendations on "Valuation and Reserve Price of Spectrum in the 700 MHz, 800 MHz, 900 MHz, 1800MHz, 2100MHz, 2300MHz and 2500 MHz bands" to DoT on 27th January, 2016.

Some of these recommendations, including spectrum usage charges, were referred back to the Authority by the DoT vide letter dated 1st April, 2016 for clarification/reconsideration. The Authority had its response to DoT on 18th April, 2016.

On 24th June, 2016 DoT again referred back the recommendations on spectrum usage charges to the Authority in the backdrop of events that took place subsequent to the Authority's response of 18th April, 2016 and other related facts.

After considering the relevant facts, the Authority has furnished response to the Government on 12th July, 2016.

Regulations :

1. Draft Telecom Consumers Protection (Tenth Amendment) regulations (TCPR), 2016 for comments of the stakeholders on longer validity for data packs (i.e. Special Tariff Vouchers with only data benefits).

TRAI released a draft Telecom Consumers Protection (Tenth Amendment) regulations (TCPR), 2016 for comments of the stakeholders on longer validity for data-packs (i.e. Special Tariff Vouchers with data benefits only) on 05.07.2016. This amendment proposes increasing the validity of STVs with exclusive data benefits to 365 days instead of 90 days being allowed presently.

Consultation Papers:

I) Consultation Paper on "Complaints/Grievance Redressal in Telecom Sector" dated 28th July, 2016

TRAI has issued a Consultation Paper on "Complaints/Grievance" Redressal in Telecom Sector" on 28th July, 2016. The Consultation Paper revisits the issue of redressal of individual consumer complaints and grievances in the telecom sector, which have grown rapidly in the last decade. The Paper presents an overview of the existing telecom consumer grievance handling mechanism and its efficacy; the mechanisms in place in other countries and in other sectors of similar size in India, andits' impact; and the problem areas. The Paper seeks views, opinions and comments from stakeholders for possible options/ alternatives on an efficient and cost-effective system for resolution of consumer complaints. II) Consultation Paper on "Proliferation of Broadband through Public Wi-Fi Networks" dated 13th July, 2016

The growth of Internet penetration in India and realization of its full potential is closely tied to the proliferation of broadband services. WLANs created using Wi-Fi technology can be used for extending the "last-mile connectivity" of broadband connections to a wider segment of users. Wi-Fi networks can offer affordable, scalable and versatile technologies that can facilitate the spread of Internet access in rural and urban areas alike. It is felt that Wi-Fi hotspots can be proliferated in every nook and corner of the country and it should be possible to set up such hotspots by shop owners and unemployed youths.

The objective of the Consultation Paper (CP) is to examine the need of encouraging public Wi-Fi networks in the country from a public policy point of view, discuss the issues in its proliferation and find out solutions for the same.The CP raises the issues of various regulatory/licensing or policy measures required to encourage ubiquitous city-wide Wi-Fi networks as well as expansion of Wi-Fi networks in remote or rural areas. The CP also touches upon interoperability between the Wi-Fi networks of different service providers as also between cellular and Wi-Fi networks, frequency bands, payment and authentication procedure to access Wi-Fi.
