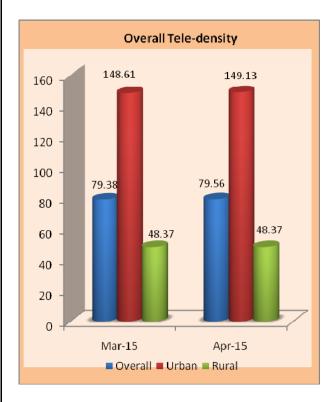

- Number of active wireless subscribers (on the date of peak VLR[#]) in April, 2015 was 869.93 million.

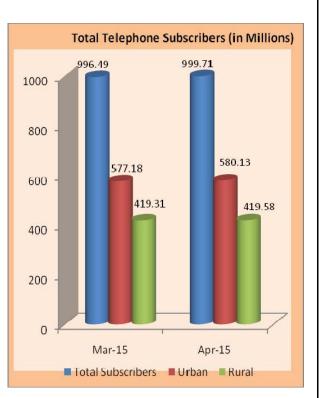

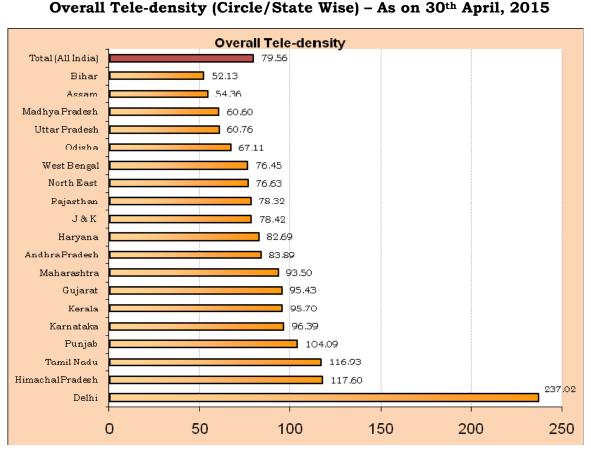
I. Total Telephone Subscribers

The number of telephone • subscribers in India increased from 996.49 million at the end of Mar-15 to 999.71 million at the end of Apr-15, thereby showing a monthly growth rate of 0.32%. The urban subscription increased from 577.18 million at the end of Mar-15 to 580.13 million at the end of Apr-15, and the rural subscription increased million from 419.31 to 419.58 million during the same period. The monthly growth rates of urban and rural subscription were 0.51% and 0.06% respectively.





• The overall Tele-density in India increased from 79.38 at the end of Mar-15 to 79.56 at the end of Apr-15. The Urban Tele-density increased from 148.61 to 149.13, and Rural Tele-density remained the same at 48.37 in the month of Apr-15. The shares of urban subscribers and rural subscribers at the end of Apr-15 were 58.03% and 41.97% respectively.



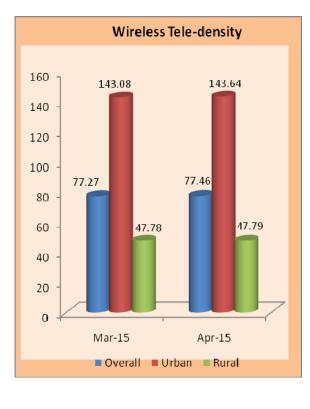
Overall Tele-density (Circle/State Wise) - As on 30th April, 2015

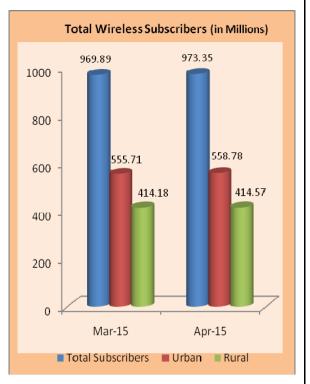

II. Wireless Subscribers

Total wireless subscriber base increased from 969.89 million at the end of Mar-15 to 973.35 million at the end of Apr-15, thereby registering a monthly growth rate of 0.36%. The Wireless subscription in urban areas increased from 555.71 million at the end of Mar-15 to 558.78 million at the end of Apr-15 and wireless subscription in rural areas increased from 414.18 million to 414.57 million during the same period. The monthly growth rates of urban and rural wireless subscription were 0.55% and 0.09% respectively.



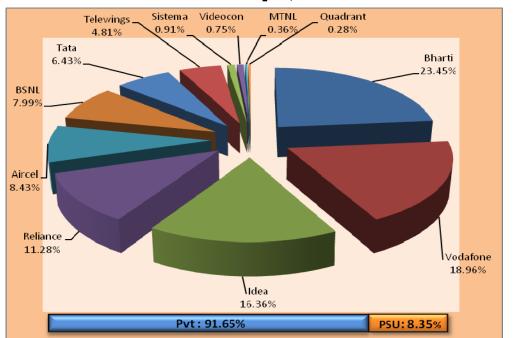


• The Wireless Tele-density in India increased from 77.27 at the end of Mar-15 to 77.46 at the end The Urban Wireless of Apr-15. Tele-density increased from 143.08 to 143.64, and Rural Wireless Teledensity slightly increased from 47.78 to 47.79 in the month of Apr-15. The shares of urban and rural wireless subscribers were 57.41% and 42.59% respectively at the end of Apr-15. Detailed statistics of wireless subscriber base is available at **Annexure-I**.

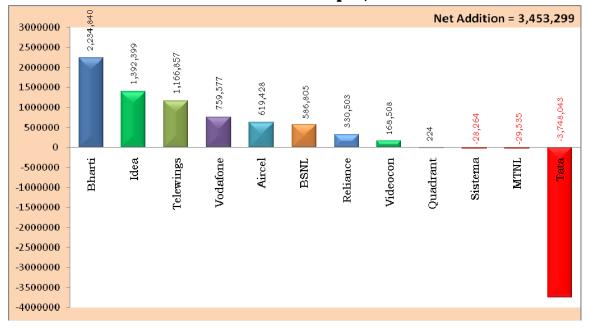
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• As on 30th April, 2015, the private access service providers held 91.65% market share of the wireless subscribers whereas BSNL and MTNL, the two PSUs access service providers, held only 8.35% market share. Access Service Provider-wise Market Shares in the Wireless Subscribers as on 30th April, 2015

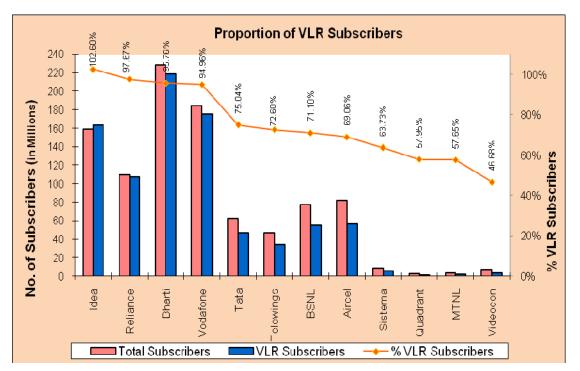


Net Additions in Wireless Subscriber Bases of Access Service Providers in the Month of April, 2015



III. Active Wireless Subscribers (VLR Data)

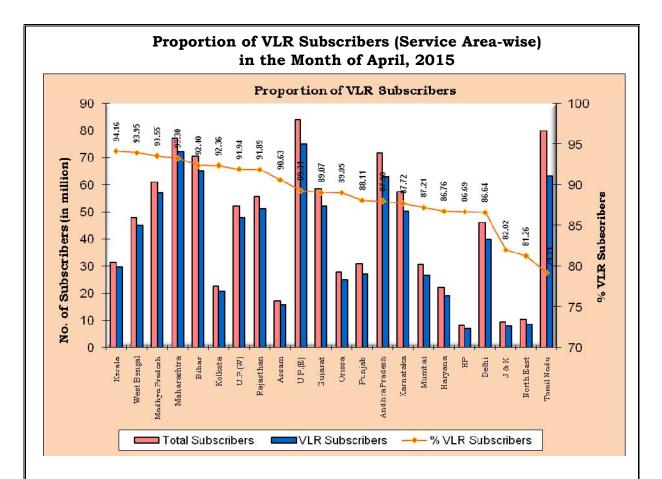
- Out of the total wireless subscriber base (973.35 million), 869.93 million wireless subscribers were active on the date of peak VLR in the month of Apr-15. The proportion of active wireless subscribers was approximately 89.38% of the total wireless subscriber base.

Access Service Provider-wise Proportion of VLR Subscribers In the Month of April, 2015

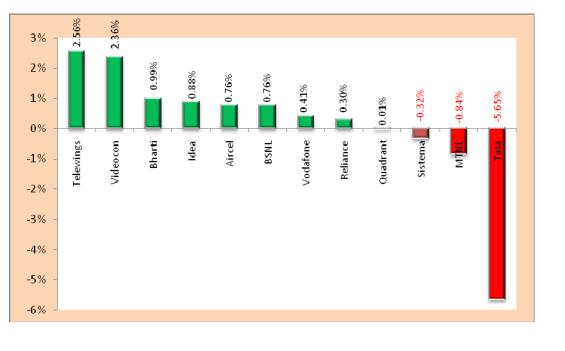

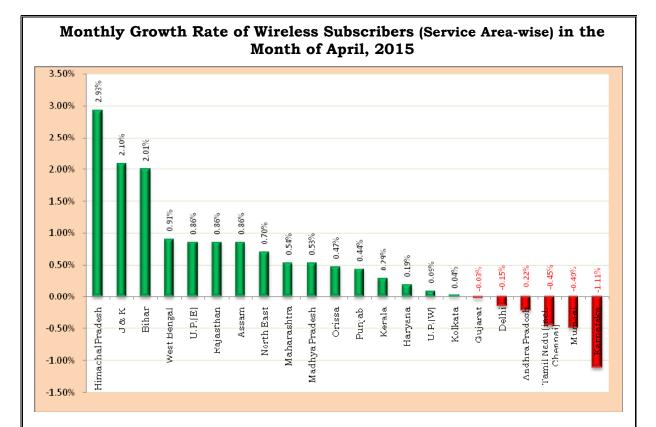

IV. Growth in Wireless Subscribers

Monthly Growth Rate of Wireless Subscribers (Access Service Provider-wise) in the Month of April, 2015





 Himachal Pradesh service area recorded the highest growth rate in wireless subscribers during the month of Apr-15, whereas Karnataka service area showed maximum decline in subscriber base during the month.

V. Mobile Number Portability

- In the month of Apr-15, a total of 3.17 million subscribers submitted their requests for MNP. With this, the cumulative MNP requests increased from 153.85 million at the end of Mar-15 to 157.01 million at the end of Apr-15.
- In MNP Zone-I (Northern and Western India), the highest number of requests till date have been received in Rajasthan (about 14.89 million) followed by Gujarat (about 12.75 million). In MNP Zone-II (Southern and Eastern India), the highest number of requests till date have been received in Karnataka (about 18.09 million) followed by Andhra Pradesh (about 14.97 million).

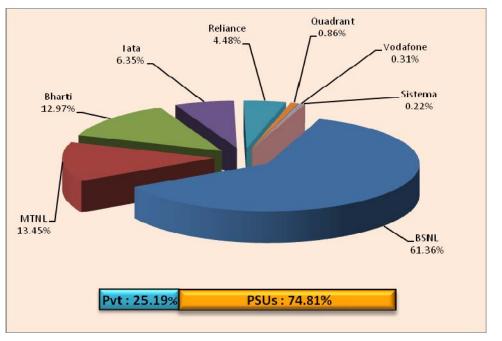

VI. Wireline Subscribers

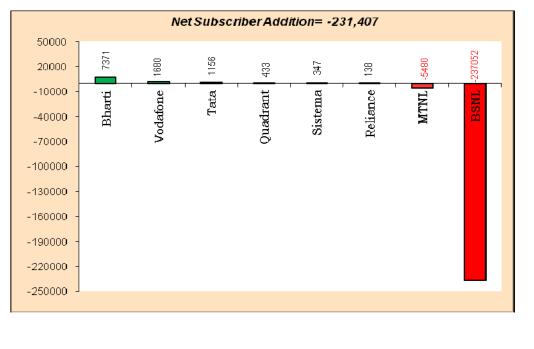
- Wireline subscriber base declined from 26.59 million at the end of Mar-15 to 26.36 million at the end of Apr-15. Net reduction in the wireline subscriber base was 0.23 million at the monthly decline rate of 0.87%. The share of urban and rural subscribers in total wireline subscribers were 81.01% and 18.99% respectively at the end of Apr-15.
- The Overall Wireline Tele-density declined from 2.12 in Mar-15 to 2.10 in Apr-15, with Urban Wireline Tele-density and Rural Wireline Tele-density being 5.49 and 0.58 respectively. BSNL and MTNL, the two PSU access service providers, held 74.81% of the wireline market share. Detailed statistics of wireline subscriber base are available at **Annexure-III**.

- As can be seen in the above tables, in wireless segment, the Circles of Category-B and C showed the net addition whereas Circles of Category-A and Metros showed net decline in subscriber base in the month of Apr-15. Circles in Category-C showed the highest monthly growth rate of subscriber base in the same period.
- In Wireline segment, Circles of Category-A showed the highest net decline and Circles in Category-C showed the highest monthly decline rate of subscriber base in the month of Apr-15.

VIII. Broadband (\geq 512 Kbps download)

• As per the reports received from the service providers, the number of broadband subscribers increased from 99.20 Million at the end of Mar-15 to 100.76 million at the end of Apr-15 with monthly growth rate of 1.57%. Segment-wise broadband subscribers and their monthly growth rates are as below:

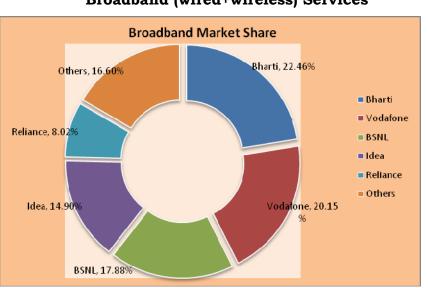

Segment-wise Broadband Subscribers and Monthly Growth Rates

• Top five service providers constituted 83.40% market share of total broadband subscribers at the end of Apr-15. These service providers were Bharti Airtel (22.63 million), Vodafone (20.30 million), BSNL (18.02 million), Idea Cellular Ltd (15.01 million) and Reliance Communications Group (8.08 million).

Note : Some wireless service providers exclude incidental data users from their subscriber base, based on minimum usage decided by them.

- As on 30th April, 2015, the top five <u>Wired</u> Broadband Service providers were BSNL (9.92 million), Bharti Airtel (1.44 million), MTNL (1.14 million), Atria Convergence Technologies (0.68 million) and YOU Broadband (0.45 million).
- As on 30th April, 2015, the top five <u>Wireless</u> Broadband Service providers were Bharti Airtel (21.19 million), Vodafone (20.29 million), Idea Cellular (15.01 million), BSNL (8.10 million) and Reliance Communications Group (7.97 million).

VLR Subscribers in the Wireless Segment

Home Location Register (HLR) is a central database that contains details of each mobile phone subscriber that is authorized to use the GSM core network. The HLRs store details of every SIM card issued by the service provider. Each SIM has a unique identifier called an International Mobile Subscriber Identity (IMSI), which is the primary key to each HLR record. The HLR data is stored for as long as a subscriber remains with the service provider. HLR also manages the mobility of subscribers by means of updating their position in administrative areas. It sends the subscriber data to a Visitor Location Register (VLR).

Subscriber numbers reported by the service providers is the difference between the numbers of IMSI registered in service provider's HLR and sum of other figures as given below:-

Visitor Location Register (VLR) is a temporary database of the subscribers who have roamed into the particular area, which it serves. Each base station in the network is served by exactly one VLR; hence a subscriber cannot be present in more than one VLR at a time.

If subscriber is in active stage i.e. he is able to send/receive calls/SMSs he is available both in HLR and VLR. However, it may be possible that the subscriber is registered in HLR but not in VLR due to the reason that he is either switched-off or moved out of coverage area, not reachable etc. In such circumstances he will be available in HLR but not in VLR. This causes difference between subscriber number reported by the service providers and numbers available in VLR.

The VLR data calculated here is on the basis of active subscribers in VLR on the date of Peak VLR of the particular month for which the data is being collected. This data is to be taken from the switches having the purge time of not more than 72 hours.
