I. Broadband Subscriber


• As per the information received from 1,126 operators in December, 2023, same as in November 2023, the total Broadband Subscribers increased from 896.61 million at the end of November-23 to 904.54 million at the end of December-23 with a monthly growth rate of 0.88%. Segment-wise broadband subscribers and their monthly growth rates are as below: -

• Top five service providers constituted 98.35% market share of the total broadband subscribers at the end of December-23. These service providers were Reliance Jio Infocomm Ltd 470.19 million, Bharti Airtel 264.76 million, Vodafone Idea 127.29 million, BSNL 25.12 million and Atria Convergence 2.23 million.


• The graphical representation of the service provider-wise market share of broadband services is given below: -




- As on 31st December, 2023, the top five <u>Wired</u> Broadband Service providers were Reliance Jio Infocomm Ltd 10.38 million, Bharti Airtel 7.39 million, BSNL 3.83 million, Atria Convergence Technologies 2.23 million and Oneott Intertainment Limited 1.21 million.
- As on 31st December, 2023, the top five <u>Wireless</u> Broadband Service providers were Reliance Jio Infocom Ltd 459.81 million, Bharti Airtel 257.37 million, Vodafone Idea 127.28 million, BSNL 21.28 million and Intech Online Pvt. Ltd. 0.24 million.

II. Wireline Subscribers

- Wireline subscribers increased from 31.57 million at the end of November-23 to 31.84 million at the end of December-23. Net increase in the wireline subscriber base was 0.28 million with a monthly rate of growth 0.87%. The share of urban and rural subscribers in total wireline subscribers were 91.46% and 8.54% respectively at the end of December, 2023.
- The Overall Wireline Tele-density in India increased from 2.26% at the end of November-23 to 2.28% at the end of December-23. Urban and Rural Wireline Tele-density were 5.88% and 0.30% respectively during the same period.
- BSNL, MTNL and APSFL, the three PSUs access service providers, held 28.27% of the wireline market share as on 31st December, 2023. Detailed statistics of wireline subscriber base are available at **Annexure-I**.

III. Wireless subscriber

Total wireless subscribers increased from 1,154.17 million at the end of November-23, to 1,158.49 million at the end of December-23, thereby registering a monthly growth rate of 0.37%. Wireless subscription in urban areas increased from 630.72 million at the end of Nov-23 to 633.44 million at the end of Dec-23 and wireless subscription in rural areas also increased from 523.45 million to 525.05 million during the same period. Monthly growth rate of urban and rural wireless subscription 0.43% 0.31% was and respectively.






The Wireless Tele-density in India increased from 82.71% at the end of November-23 to 82.95% at the end of December-23. The Urban Wireless Teledensity increased from 127.53% at the end of November-23 to 127.88% at the end of December-23 and Rural Tele-density also increased from 58.10% to 58.26% during the same period. The share of urban and rural wireless subscribers in total number of wireless subscribers was 54.68% and 45.32% respectively at the end of Dec-23. Detailed statistics of wireless subscriber base is available at **Annexure-II**.



As on 31st December, 2023, the private access service providers held 91.90% market share of the wireless subscribers whereas BSNL and MTNL, the two PSU access service providers, had a market share of only 8.10%.


The graphical representation of access service provider-wise market share • and net additions in wireless subscriber base are given below: -

IV. Total Telephone Subscribers


• The number of telephone subscribers in India increased from 1,185.73 million at the end of November-23 to 1,190.33 million at the end of December-23. thereby showing a monthly growth rate of 0.39%. Urban telephone subscription increased from 659.58 million at the end of November-23 to 662.56 million at the end of December-23 and the rural subscription also increased from 526.15 million to 527.77 million during the same period. The monthly growth rates of urban and rural telephone subscription were 0.45% and 0.31% respectively during the month of December-23.





• The overall Tele-density in India increased from 84.97% at the end of November-23 to 85.23% at the end of December-23. The Urban Tele-density increased from 133.36% at the end of November-23 to 133.76% at the end of December-23 and Rural Tele-density also increased from 58.40% to 58.56% during the same period. The share of urban and rural subscribers in total number of telephone subscribers at the end of December-23 were 55.66% and 44.34% respectively.

 As may be seen in the above chart, eight LSA have less tele-density than the all India average tele-density at the end of December-23. Delhi service area has maximum tele-density of 278.28% and the Bihar service area has minimum tele-density of 56.43% at the end of December-23.



- During the month of December, 2023, in Wireline segment, both on monthly and yearly basis, all circles have registered growth rate in their subscriber base.


VI. Active Wireless Subscribers (VLR Data)

- Out of the total 1,158.49 million wireless subscribers, 1047.88 million wireless subscribers were active on the date of peak VLR in the month of December-23. The of active wireless proportion subscribers approximately was 90.45% of the total wireless subscriber base.
- The detailed statistics on proportion active of wireless subscribers (also referred to as VLR subscribers) on the date of peak VLR in the month of December-23 is available at Annexure-III and the methodology used for reporting VLR subscribers is available at **Annexure-IV**.

 Bharti Airtel has the maximum proportion 98.90% of its active wireless subscribers (VLR) as against its total wireless subscribers (HLR) on the date of peak VLR in the month of December-23 and MTNL has the minimum proportion of VLR 25.98% of its HLR during the same period.



VII. Mobile Number Portability (MNP)

- Intra-service area Mobile number portability (MNP) was implemented first in Haryana service area w.e.f. 25.11.2010 and in the rest of the country w.e.f. 20.01.2011. Inter-Service Area MNP has been implemented in the country w.e.f. 03.07.2015. Now, the wireless telephone subscribers can retain their mobile numbers when they relocate from one service area to another.
- During the month of December-23, a total of 12.44 million requests were received for MNP. Out of total 12.44 million, new requests received from Zone-I & Zone-II were 7.03 million and 5.41 million respectively. The cumulative MNP requests increased from 914.75 million at the end of November-23 to 927.19 million at the end of December-23, since the implementation of MNP.

- In MNP Zone-I (Northern and Western India), the highest number of requests till date have been received in Uttar Pradesh-East (about 85.43 million) followed by Maharashtra (about 76.25 million) service area.
- In MNP Zone-II (Southern and Eastern India), the highest number of requests till date have been received in Madhya Pradesh (about 71.32 million) followed by Karnataka (about 65.21 million).

VLR Subscribers in the Wireless Segment

Home Location Register (HLR) is a central database that contains details of each mobile phone subscriber that is authorized to use the GSM core network. The HLRs store details of every SIM card issued by the service provider. Each SIM has a unique identifier called an International Mobile Subscriber Identity (IMSI), which is the primary key to each HLR record. The HLR data is stored for as long as a subscriber remains with the service provider. HLR also manages the mobility of subscribers by means of updating their position in administrative areas. It sends the subscriber data to a Visitor Location Register (VLR).

Subscriber numbers reported by the service providers is the difference between the numbers of IMSI registered in service provider's HLR and sum of other figures as given below: -

Visitor Location Register (VLR) is a temporary database of the subscribers who have roamed into the particular area, which it serves. Each base station in the network is served by exactly one VLR; hence a subscriber cannot be present in more than one VLR at a time.

If subscriber is in active stage i.e. he is able to send/receive calls/SMSs he is available both in HLR and VLR. However, it may be possible that the subscriber is registered in HLR but not in VLR due to the reason that he is either switched-off or moved out of coverage area, not reachable etc. In such circumstances he will be available in HLR but not in VLR. This causes difference between subscriber number reported by the service providers based on HLR and numbers available in VLR.

The VLR subscriber data calculated here is based on active subscribers in VLR on the date of Peak subscriber number in VLR of the particular month for which the data is being collected. This data is to be taken from the switches having the purge time of not more than 72 hours.
