TRAI disallows higher call charges in respect of calls to MTNL/BSNL Mobile (GSM) Networks

TRAI has intervened in the tariff schemes of Idea Cellular and

Hutch, which involved differential rates for calls terminated in the

networks of Private GSM operators. Such differential rates created a

situation where Idea & Hutch subscribers had to pay higher charges

for calling the MTNL/BSNL mobile (GSM) subscribers.

Idea and Hutch had classified subscribers who terminate calls on

private GSM networks as a separate class of subscribers for the

purpose of applying differential tariff. The Authority viewed such

classification as arbitrary and inconsistent with the provisions of

Telecommunication 10 Tariff Orders. Clause of the

Telecommunication Tariff Orders (TTO), 1999 provides that no

Service Provider shall, in any manner, discriminate between

subscribers of the same class and such classification of the subscribers

shall not be arbitrary.

Both Idea and Hutch have withdrawn the differential tariffs and

have reported compliance to the Authority.
