
- ❖ In the month of December, 2015, 7.31 million subscribers submitted their requests for Mobile Number Portability (MNP). With this, the cumulative MNP requests increased from 186.69 million at the end of November, 2015 to 194.01 million at the end of December, 2015.
- ❖ Number of active wireless subscribers (on the date of peak VLR[#]) in December, 2015 was 912.06 million.



I. Total Telephone Subscribers


• The number of telephone subscribers in India increased from 1,035.18 million at the end of Nov-15 to 1,036.41 million at the end of Dec-15, thereby showing a monthly growth rate of 0.12%. The urban subscription increased from 598.92 million at the end of Nov-15 to 600.66 million at the end of Dec-15 whereas the rural subscription declined from 436.26 million to 435.75 million during the same period. The monthly growth rates of urban and rural subscription were 0.29% and -0.12% respectively during the month of Dec-15.





• The overall Tele-density in India slightly increased from 81.82 at the end of Nov-15 to 81.83 at the end of Dec-15. The Urban Tele-density increased from 152.25 at the end of Nov-15 to 152.45 at the end of Dec-15. The Rural Tele-density declined from 50.04 at the end of Nov-15 to 49.94 at the end of Dec-15. The share of urban subscribers and rural subscribers at the end of Dec-15 was 57.96% and 42.04% respectively.








II. Wireless Subscribers

wireless subscriber Total base increased from 1,009.46 million at the end of Nov-15 to 1,010.89 million at the end of Dec-15, thereby registering a monthly growth rate of 0.14%. The Wireless subscription in urban areas increased from 577.84 million at the end of Nov-15 to 579.67 million at the end of Dec-15, whereas wireless subscription in rural areas slightly declined from 431.61 million to 431.22 million during the same The monthly growth rates of period. urban and rural wireless subscription were 0.32% and -0.09% respectively.







• The Wireless Tele-density in India increased from 79.78 at the end of Nov-15 to 79.82 at the end of Dec-15. Urban Wireless Tele-density increased from 146.89 to 147.12, whereas Rural Wireless Tele-density declined from 49.51 in Nov-15 to 49.43 in the month of Dec-15. The share of urban and rural wireless subscribers was 57.34% and 42.66% respectively at the end of Dec-15. statistics Detailed of wireless subscriber base is available Annexure-I.

• As on 31st December, 2015, the private access service providers held 91.48% market share of the wireless subscribers whereas BSNL and MTNL, the two PSUs access service providers, had only 8.52% market share. The graphical representations of access service provider-wise market share and net additions in wireless subscriber bases are given below:

Access Service Provider-wise Market Shares in term of Wireless Subscriber base as on 31st December, 2015




Net Additions in Wireless Subscriber Bases of Access Service Providers in the Month of December, 2015



III. Active Wireless Subscribers (VLR Data)

- Out of the total wireless subscriber base (1,010.89 million), 912.06 million wireless subscribers were active on the date of peak VLR in the month of Dec-15. The proportion of active wireless subscribers was approximately 90.22% of the total wireless subscriber base.
- The detailed statistics on proportion of active wireless subscribers (also referred to as VLR subscribers) on the date of peak VLR in the month of Dec-15 is available at **Annexure-II** and the methodology used for reporting VLR subscribers is available at **Annexure-IV**.


Access Service Provider-wise Proportion of VLR Subscribers in the Month of December, 2015


Service Area wise proportion of VLR Subscribers in the Month of December, 2015




IV. Growth in Wireless Subscribers

Access Service Provider-wise Monthly Growth Rate of Wireless Subscriber base in the Month of December, 2015







• Kolkata service area recorded the highest growth rate in wireless subscribers during the month of Dec-15, whereas West Bengal service area showed maximum decline in subscriber base during the month.

V. Mobile Number Portability (MNP)

- Intra-service area Mobile number portability (MNP) has been implemented in Haryana service area w.e.f. 25.11.2010 and in the rest of the country w.e.f. 20.01.2011. Inter-Service Area MNP has been implemented in the country w.e.f. 03.07.2015. Now, the wireless telephone subscribers can retain their mobile numbers when they relocate from one service area to another.
- In the month of Dec-15, a total of 7.31 million requests were received for MNP. With this, the cumulative MNP requests increased from 186.69 million at the end of Nov-15 to 194.01 million at the end of Dec-15.
- In MNP Zone-I (Northern and Western India), the highest number of requests till date have been received in Rajasthan (about 17.32 million) followed by Gujarat (about 15.17 million).

 In MNP Zone-II (Southern and Eastern India), the highest number of requests till date have been received in Karnataka (about 22.01 million) followed by Andhra Pradesh (about 18.60 million).



VI. Wireline Subscribers


- Wireline subscriber base declined from 25.72 million at the end of Nov-15 to 25.52 million at the end of Dec-15. Net reduction in the wireline subscriber base was 0.21 million at the monthly decline rate of 0.80%. The share of urban and rural subscribers in total wireline subscribers were 82.25% and 17.75% respectively at the end of Dec-15.
- The Overall Wireline Tele-density slightly declined from 2.03 in Nov-15 to 2.01 in Dec-15. Urban Wireline Tele-density and Rural Wireline Tele-density being 5.33 and 0.52 respectively.

- BSNL and MTNL, the two PSU access service providers, held 73.09% of the wireline market share. Detailed statistics of wireline subscriber base are available at **Annexure-III**.

• As can be seen in the above tables, in wireless segment, the Circles of Category-B showed the maximum net addition and Circles in Metro showed the maximum growth rate in the month Dec-15. Circles in Category-C showed decline during the month. In Wireline segment, Circles of Category-A showed the highest net decline and Circles in Category-C showed the highest monthly decline rate of subscriber base in the month of Dec-15.

VIII. Broadband (≥ 512 Kbps download)

• As per the reports received from the service providers, the number of broadband subscribers increased from 131.49 Million at the end of Nov-15 to 136.53 million at the end of Dec-15 with monthly growth rate of 3.83%. Segment-wise broadband subscribers and their monthly growth rates are as below:



• Top five service providers constituted 83.41% market share of total broadband subscribers at the end of Dec-15. These service providers were Bharti Airtel (31.49 million), Vodafone (25.91 million), Idea Cellular (21.21 million), BSNL (19.85 million) and Reliance Communications Group (15.41 million).

Note: Some wireless service providers exclude incidental data users from their subscriber base, based on minimum usage decided by them.

- As on 31st December, 2015, the top five <u>Wired</u> Broadband Service providers were BSNL (9.92 million), Bharti Airtel (1.67 million), MTNL (1.12 million), Atria Convergence Technologies (0.86 million) and YOU Broadband (0.51 million).
- As on 31st December, 2015, the top five <u>Wireless</u> Broadband Service providers were Bharti Airtel (29.82 million), Vodafone (25.91 million), Idea Cellular (21.21 million), Reliance Communications Group (15.30 million) and BSNL (9.93 million).

VLR Subscribers in the Wireless Segment

Home Location Register (HLR) is a central database that contains details of each mobile phone subscriber that is authorized to use the GSM core network. The HLRs store details of every SIM card issued by the service provider. Each SIM has a unique identifier called an International Mobile Subscriber Identity (IMSI), which is the primary key to each HLR record. The HLR data is stored for as long as a subscriber remains with the service provider. HLR also manages the mobility of subscribers by means of updating their position in administrative areas. It sends the subscriber data to a Visitor Location Register (VLR).

Subscriber numbers reported by the service providers is the difference between the numbers of IMSI registered in service provider's HLR and sum of other figures as given below:-

Visitor Location Register (VLR) is a temporary database of the subscribers who have roamed into the particular area, which it serves. Each base station in the network is served by exactly one VLR; hence a subscriber cannot be present in more than one VLR at a time.

If subscriber is in active stage i.e. he is able to send/receive calls/SMSs he is available both in HLR and VLR. However, it may be possible that the subscriber is registered in HLR but not in VLR due to the reason that he is either switched-off or moved out of coverage area, not reachable etc. In such circumstances he will be available in HLR but not in VLR. This causes difference between subscriber number reported by the service providers and numbers available in VLR.

The VLR data calculated here is on the basis of active subscribers in VLR on the date of Peak VLR of the particular month for which the data is being collected. This data is to be taken from the switches having the purge time of not more than 72 hours.
