Sub:- Calling applications for filling up the post of Senior Research Officer on deputation on foreign service terms.

Sir,

Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI), New Delhi is a statutory body set up under an Act of Parliament viz. TRAI Act, 1997. TRAI has been established to regulate the Telecommunications Services and to protect the interest of service providers and consumers of the telecom sector, to promote and ensure orderly growth of the telecom sector and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto. The functions relating to regulation of Broadcasting and Cable Services Sectors have also been entrusted to TRAI from 2004.

2. The organization proposes to prepare a panel of officers having the required experience for appointment as Senior Research Officer on deputation on foreign service terms initially for a period of two years. The details of qualification and experience etc, are as under:-

The officer must possess the working knowledge of computer. <u>Essential:-</u> A Master/Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration /Economics/Commerce/Engineering/Law/ Science/ Humanities from a recognized University/ Institution or, Membership of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India/ Institute of Cost and Works Accountants of India and possessing requisite experience in the relevant field. <u>Age:-</u> Not exceeding 56 years on the date of closing of applications.

3. The qualification and experience prescribed for the post can be relaxed in deserving cases at the discretion of the competent authority.

4. These posts have been exempted from the rule of immediate absorption for a period of three years by Department of Pension & Pensioners Welfare for appointment on deputation.

5. All the Ministries/Departments, Public Sector Undertakings and Statutory and Autonomous Bodies are requested to forward applications in the enclosed proforma (can also be downloaded from TRAI website www.traigov.in) along with attested copies of ACRs for the last five years and vigilance/disciplinary clearance of eligible candidates whose services could be placed at the disposal of the Authority immediately in an envelope superscribing the post applied for so as to reach the Senior Research Officer (A&P), Telecom Regulatory Authority of India, Mahanagar Doorsanchar Bhawan, J.L. Nehru Marg, (Old Minto Road), next to Zakir Hussain College, New Delhi-110002 on or before 24th September, 2010.

6. Those who have applied against the earlier vacancy notices issued during May-July, 2010 by TRAI for the posts of Senior Research Officer need not apply again. Their advance copies already received with reference to earlier notices would be considered only on receipt of their applications through proper channel.
