## TRAI recommends enhancement of Foreign Direct Investment limits in Broadcasting Sector

**New Delhi, 22**<sup>nd</sup> **August, 2013:** The Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) has today released its recommendations on Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) limits and approval routes thereof in various segments of the broadcasting sector in India.

2. These recommendations broadly pertain to three segments of the broadcasting sector viz. broadcast carriage services, television content services and FM radio services. The FDI limit for the broadcast carriage services has been recommended for enhancement to 100% and that for uplinking of 'News and Current Affairs' TV channels and FM radio services to 49%. In has also been recommended that the FIPB approval process be streamlined and made time-bound. Summary of the recommendations *vis a vis* existing limits/approval route has been tabulated as under:
